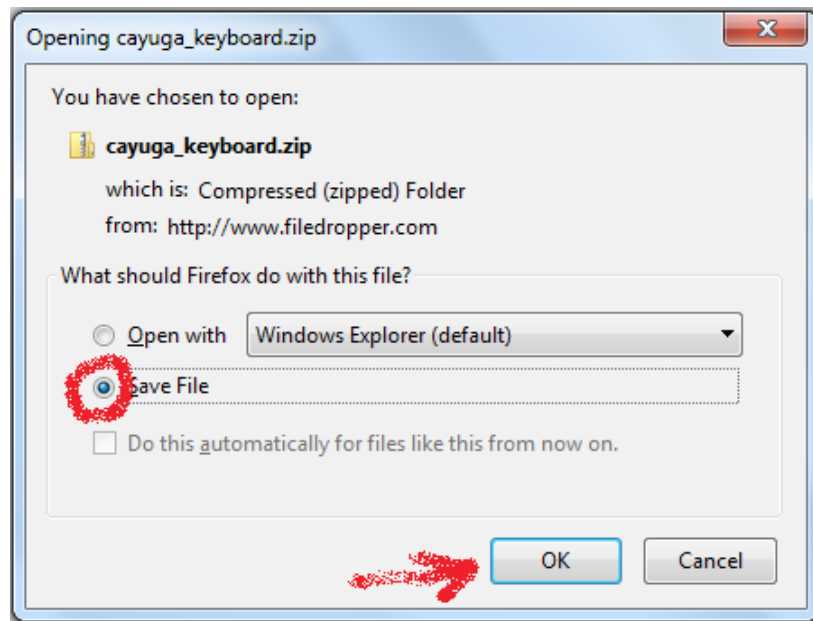
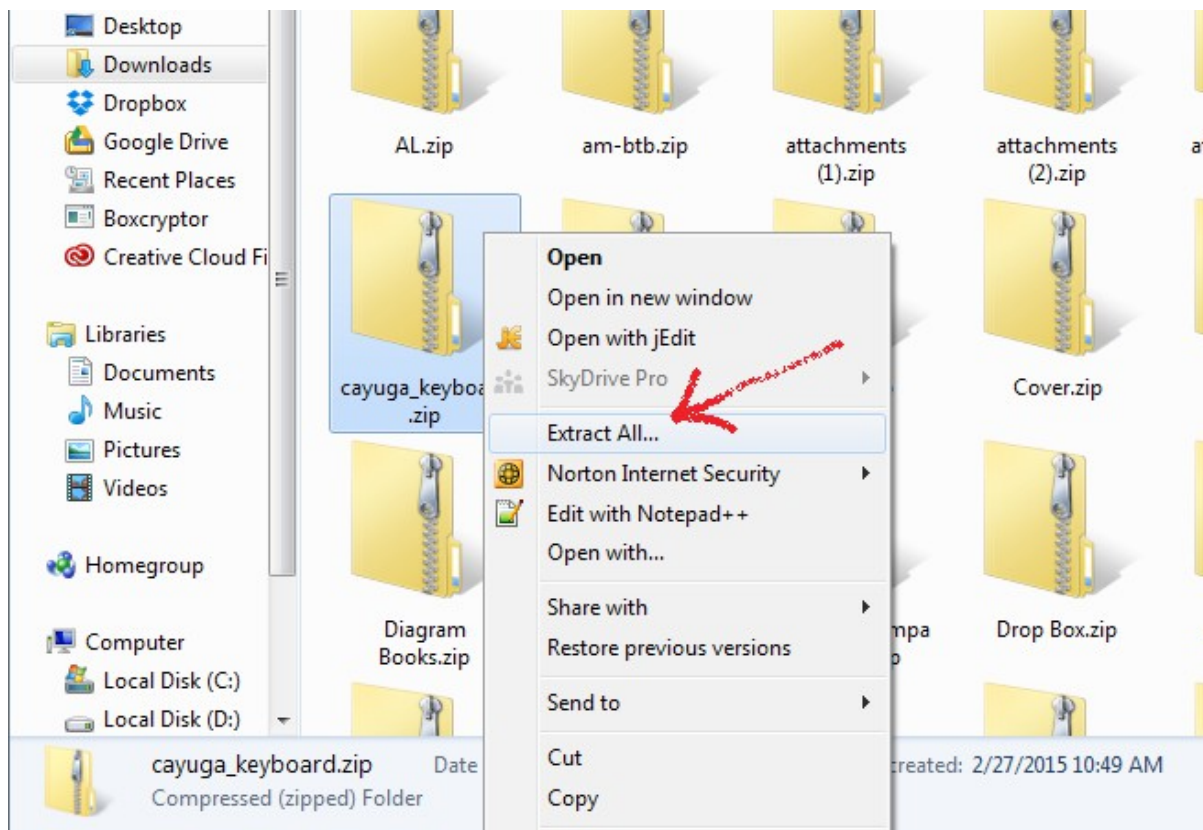


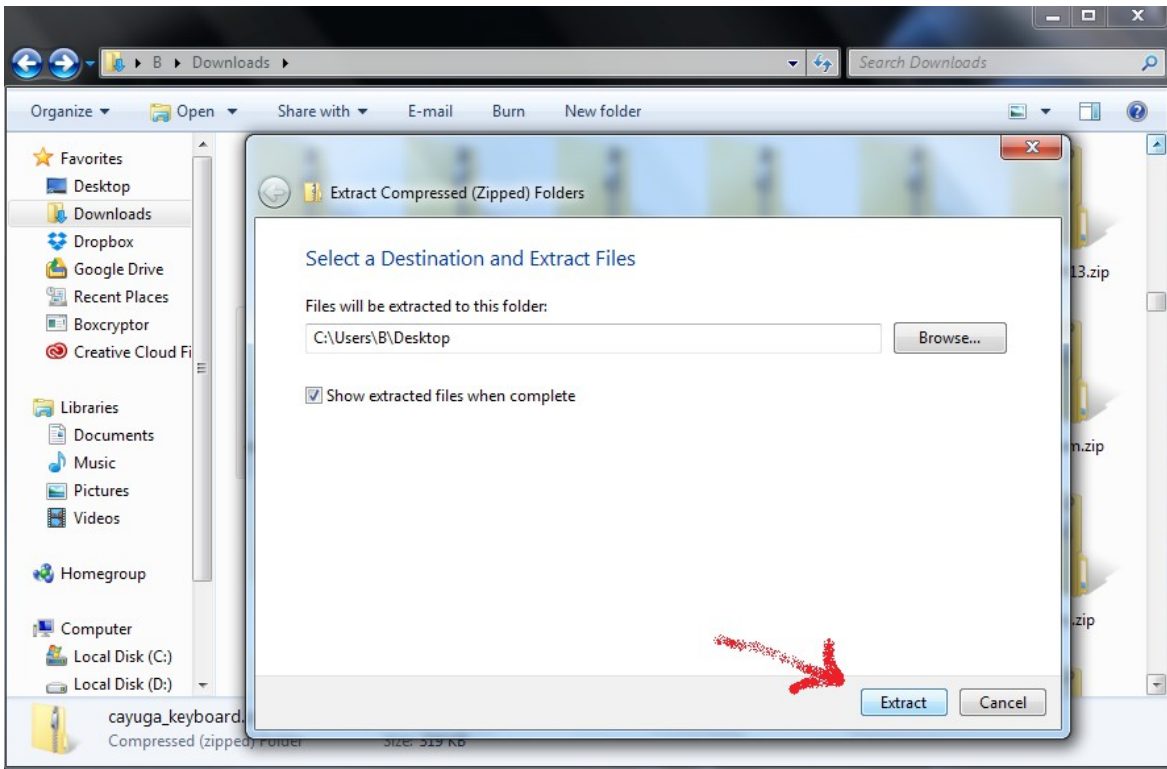
Download the zip file containing the keyboard.



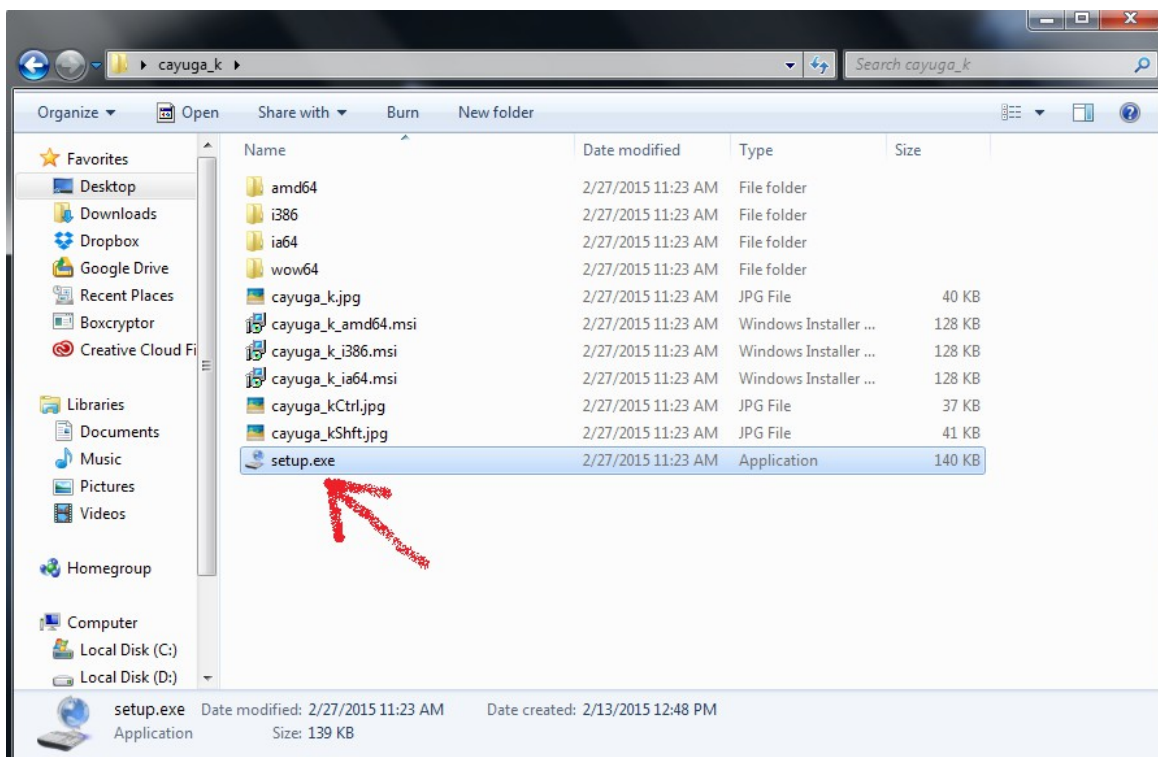
Go to the folder where you've saved the file. Unzip it by right clicking and selecting "Extract All..."



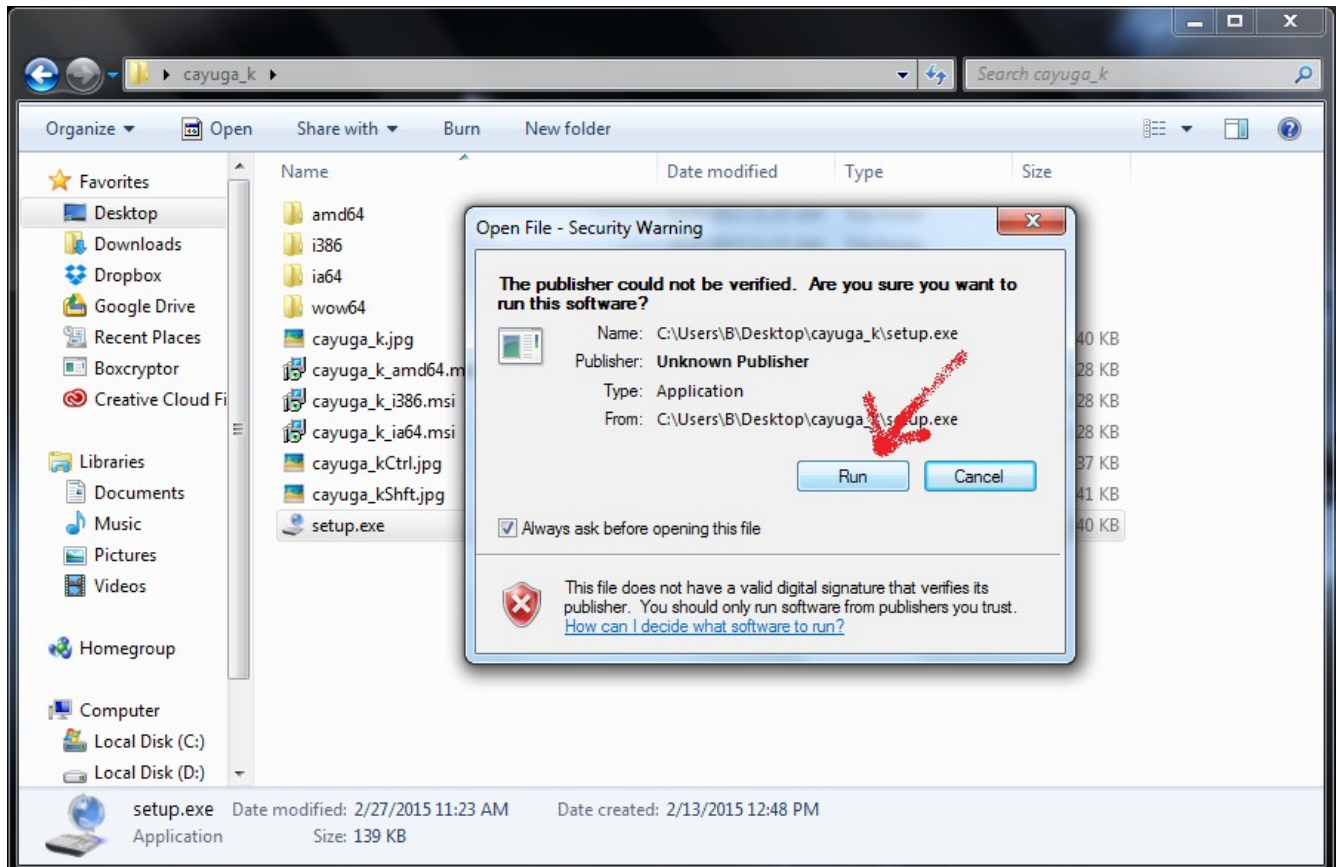
Select the folder you want to extract the files to and click “Extract”.



Go to the unzipped folder and double click on “setup.exe”.

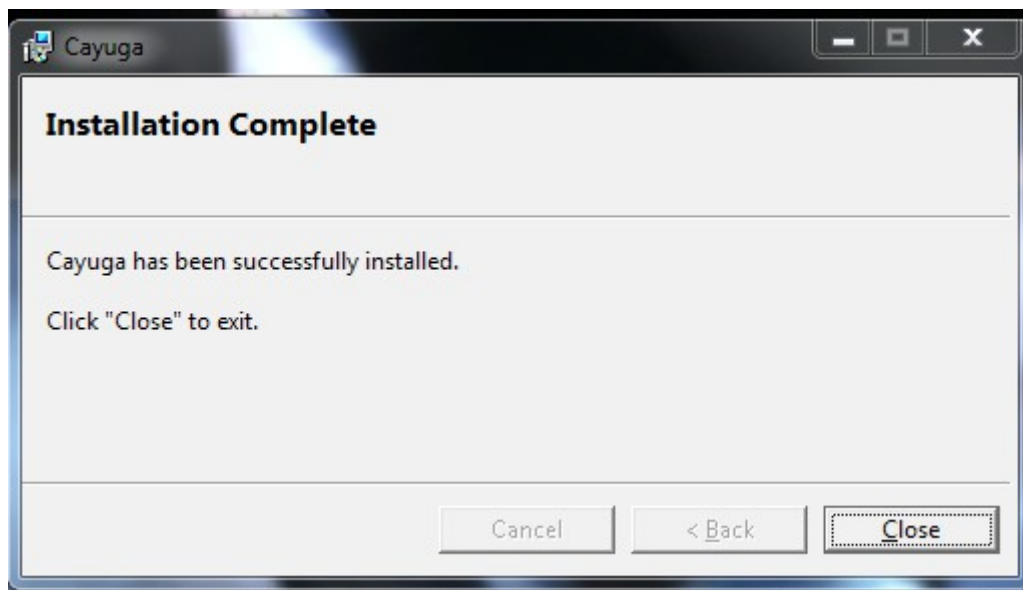


Click "Run" when asked if you want to run the software.

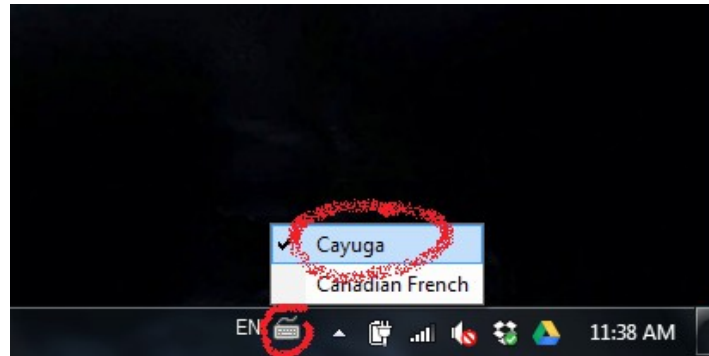


You might be asked to enter an admin password at this point. Enter the password and click "Yes".

Wait for the keyboard to install. You'll see this window when installation is complete. Click "Close".



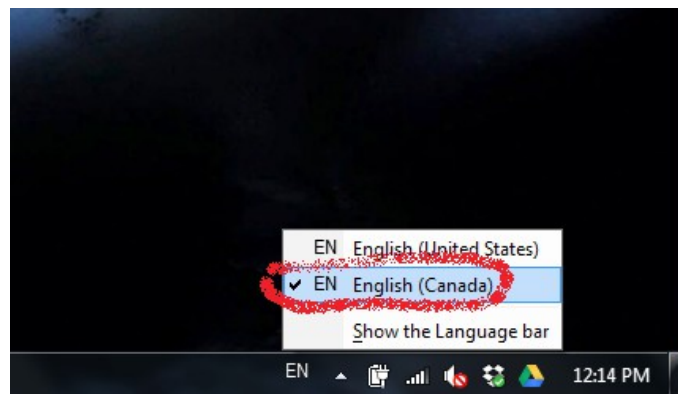
Click on the language bar in the bottom right corner of your screen and select “Cayuga” from the list that appears.



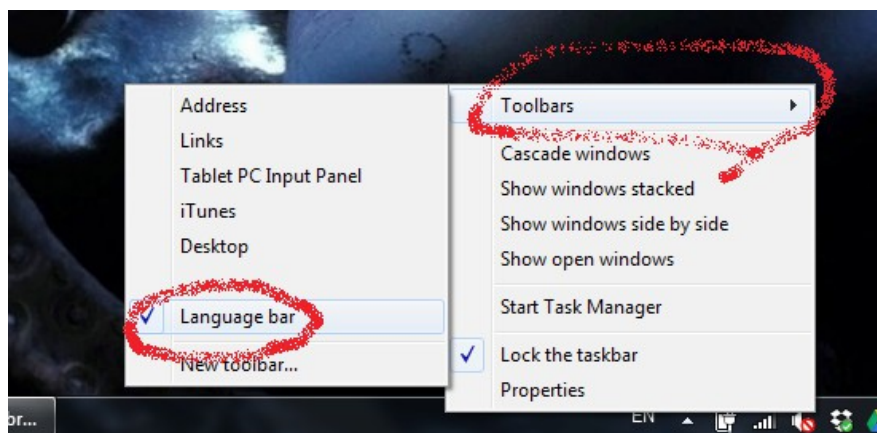
Now you're ready to type in Cayuga!

Please note that if you open a new program like Microsoft Word or a browser like Chrome, you may have to change the language in the language bar again in order to be able to type in Cayuga.

If you don't have any other languages installed under “English (Canada)”, it might not show up as “Cayuga”. Just select “English (Canada)” instead.

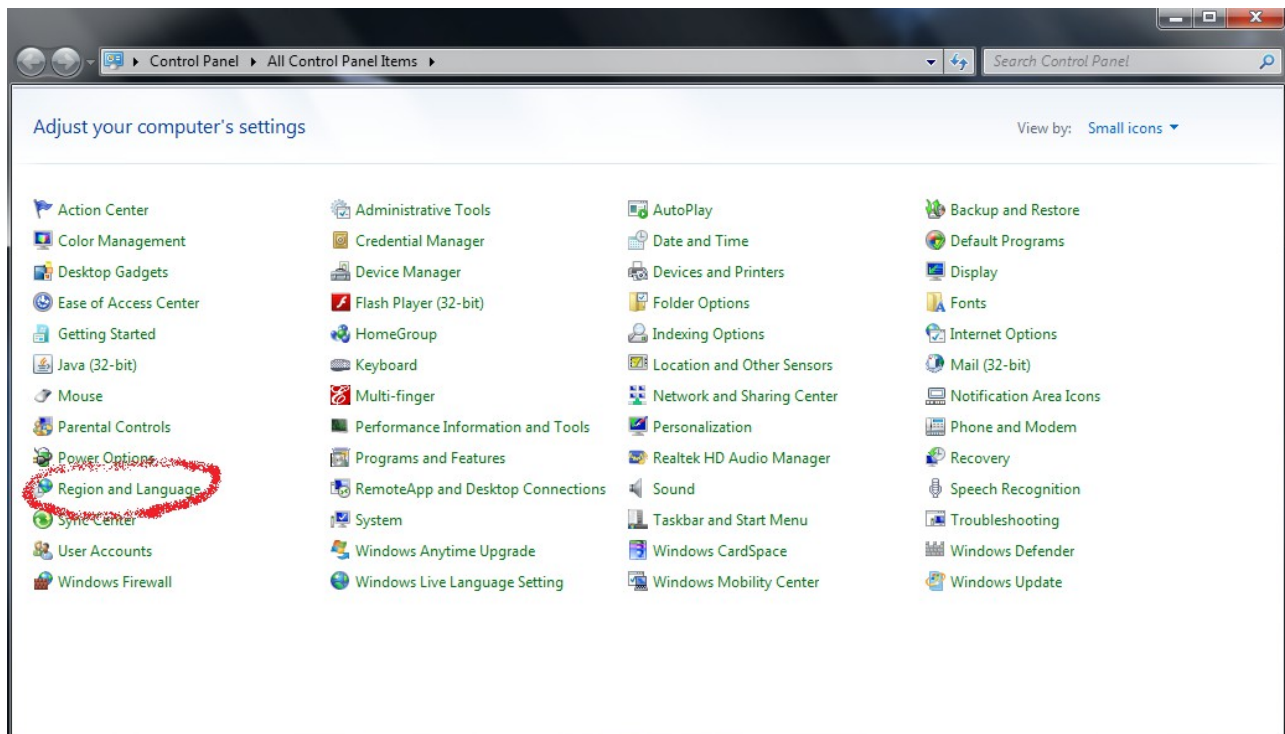
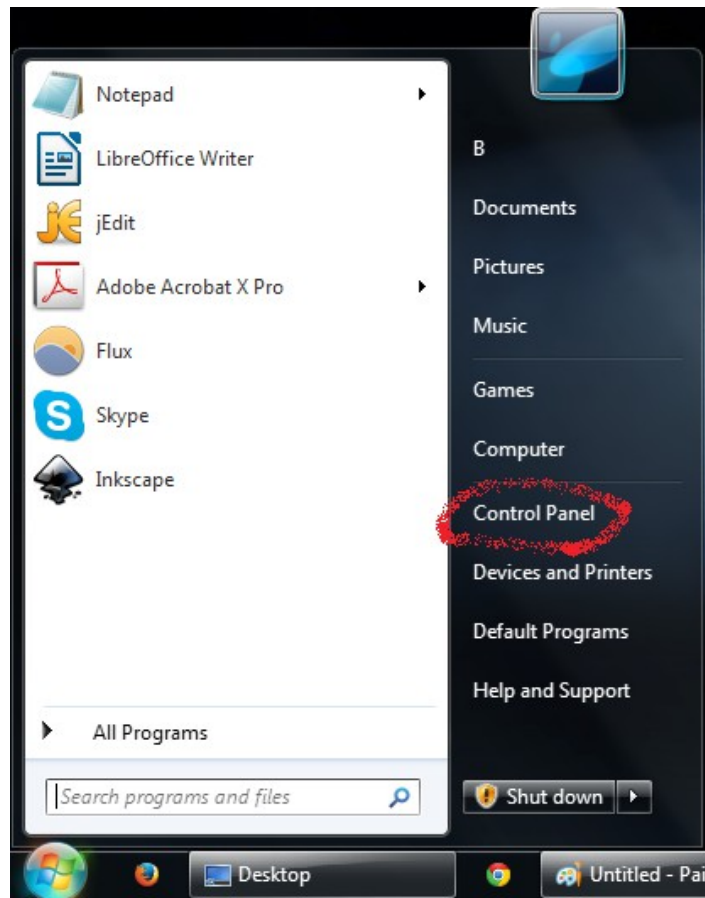


If you don't see the language bar, right click on the taskbar, click on “Toolbars” and then select “Language bar”.

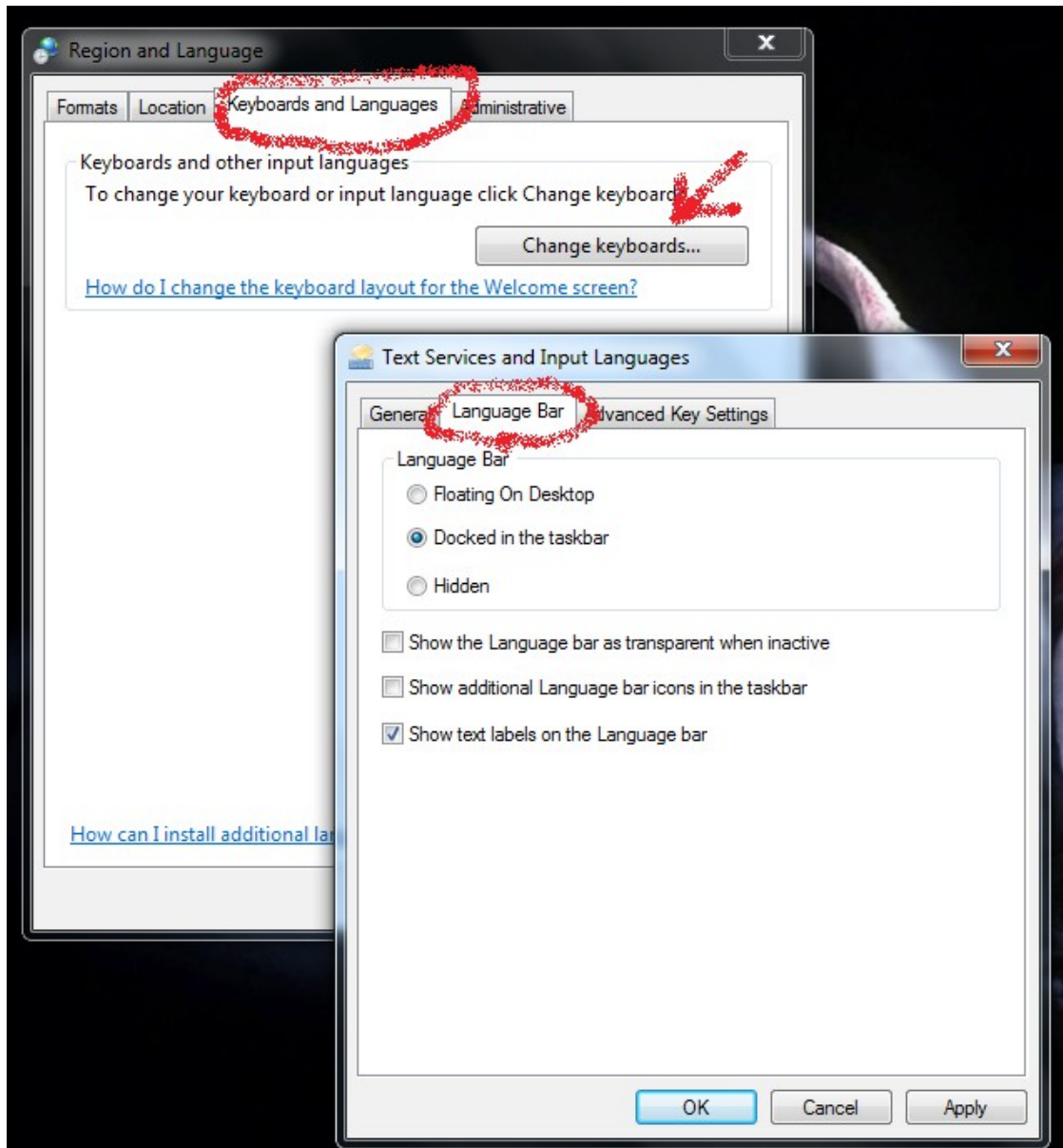




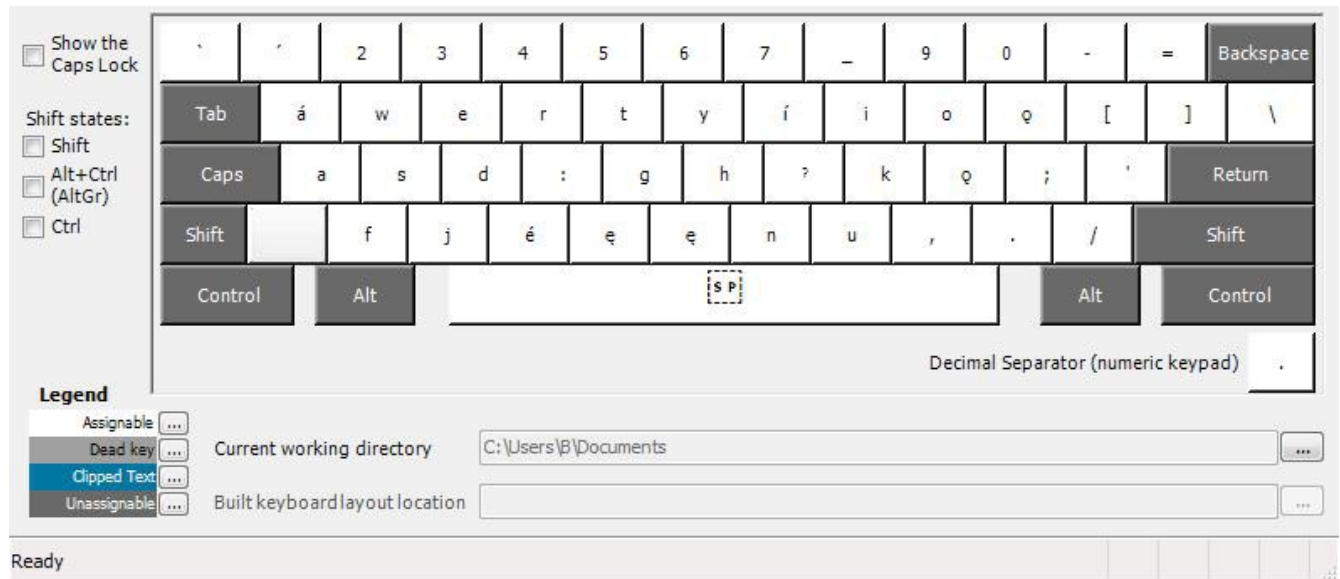
If the language bar isn't on the list of toolbars, go to control panel and click on "Region and Languages".



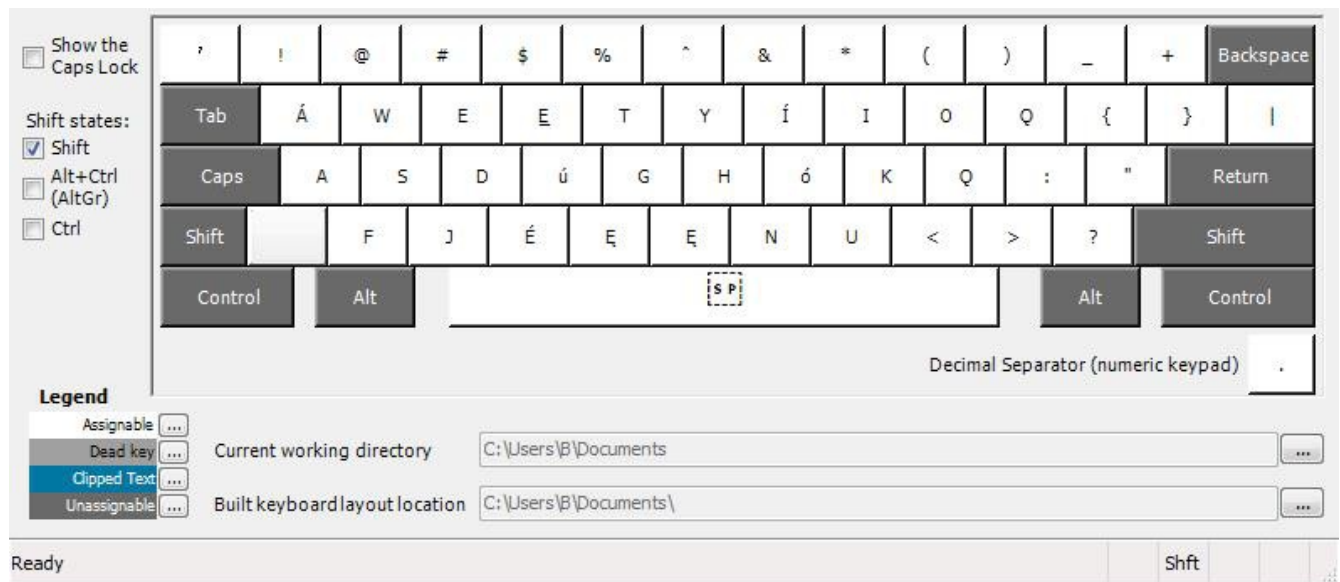
Click on the “Keyboards and Languages” tab and then the “Change keyboards...” button. Click on the “Language Bar” tab in the window that opens. Select “Floating on desktop” or “Docked in the taskbar”. Click OK in both windows.



This is what the keyboard layout looks like (you can find pictures of the layout in the zipped download folder as well):



This is what it looks like when you hold down the shift key:



If you want to type accented vowels, type the vowel and then type ´ (same as “1” on a regular keyboard).

á é ê í ó ó ú

You don’t have to do this combination for everything. Some accented vowels (á, é, í, ó, ú) are already in the keyboard if you look at the keyboard layout again.

If you want to type underlined vowels, type the vowel and then type \_ (same as “8” on a regular keyboard).

a e ë i o u

To type vowels with a circumflex, type the vowel and then type shift+6.
